#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Jn 8:31-42

Jesus said to those Jews who believed in him, "If you remain in my word, you will truly be my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." They answered him, "We are descendants of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How can you say, 'You will become free'?" Jesus answered them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is a slave of sin. A slave does not remain in a household forever, but a son always remains. So if a son frees you, then you will truly be free. I know that you are descendants of Abraham. But you are trying to kill me, because my word has no room among you. I tell you what I have seen in the Father's presence; then do what you have heard from the Father."

They answered and said to him, "Our father is Abraham." Jesus said to

They answered and said to him, "Our father is Abraham." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works of Abraham. But now you are trying to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God; Abraham did not do this. You are doing the works of your father!" So they said to him, "We are not illegitimate. We have one Father, God." Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and am here; I did not come on my own, but he sent me."

If you remain in my word.

Jesus now addresses the Jews who have believed in him. For them to become his disciples, they have to remain, be with him, and accept his word. But these Jews cannot understand Jesus when he speaks to them about the truth that will set them free. They believe they are free because they are descendants of Abraham. But Jesus is referring to freedom from sin. Sin in this context is the refusal to accept Jesus as the Son of God. The Jews cannot accept the truth that Jesus came from the Father, that he is divine. The paradox in the Gospel is that it starts with the Jews believing in Jesus but concludes with unbelief: they want to kill Jesus (v40).

Our faith in Jesus must grow from being a "dormant faith" to an "active faith"; we can do this only by remaining in Jesus' word, being faithful to his teachings. Accepting the salvation offered by Jesus will free us from our enslavement to self-righteousness and self-centeredness; then we will experience the joy of being his true disciples.

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Freedom does not mean we can do whatever we like, True freedom is manifested in doing what pleases God.

#### Quality Catholic schools Survey

All Catholic schools in the Diocese of Parramatta will be once again participating in the Quality Catholic Schooling (QCS) survey.

The QCS survey provides information from students, staff and parents about our school's cultural behaviour, relationships and learning community, and assists us in our focus on continuous improvement.

Between 21 March and 1 April 2016 all staff and *Years* 5 & 6 students, and 60 randomly-selected parents will be asked to complete an online survey. Staff and students will complete the survey online at school. Parents will be sent home a paper survey but will also be able to complete the survey online if preferred. The survey will take about 20-30 minutes to complete. This year we will again be able to get even more information about the link between student wellbeing and learning outcomes. To do this we will need to include a student identifier in the student survey. The survey will still remain confidential and individual survey responses will not be accessible by the school or the Catholic Education Office.

An independent survey consultant (Insight SRC) who manages the data collection will ensure the survey data is kept strictly confidential. Each school will receive a de-identified information report at the end of May to help them to develop strategies for further improvement. This will definitely help us in working with all students to improve their learning. If you have concerns, please feel free to contact Mrs Joanna Delvecchio.

As a parent if you are randomly-selected to complete the survey, I would encourage your participation as this will help our school to identify our strengths and areas in which we can focus our improvement.

#### FROM THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

#### PBS4L (Positive Behaviours Support for Learning)

Over the last 12 months, the school has been preparing for the launch of the PBS4L in our school. Lisa Bow and Anoushka Houseman, who have been working with the staff, spoke at the P&F meeting the other night about this project. This project aims to put consistent and positive behaviour management in the school around our three main rules; I am Safe, I am Respectful and I am a Learner. The students have been engaging in lessons on these three rules and what it looks like when students are following these rules across the different areas around the school. We have also put into place a consequences flow chart and a reward system to reward positive behaviours. We are still in the early stages of implementation and we are also in the process of trialling and refining these as we lead up to the launch next term. Once we have the consequences flow chart and reward system finalised and in place, we will update you with information through the newsletter.

#### **PRACTICUM TEACHERS**

Over the next two terms we will have some Practicum teachers working at St Josephs. Over the last few weeks we have had Jessica Delaney working in Kindergarten under the supervision of Mrs Katie Bates. Over the next few weeks we welcome Rona Feraset, who will be in Year 2 and Clare Nguyen who will be in Year 3. They will begin this term and early next term with day a week visits with the class they will be working with and complete their practicum with a three week block at the end of term 2. We also welcome Fatima Llagin who will be working in various classes across the school as she is in her first year.



#### **Mufti Day**


