## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Sunday Gospel for 17 May, 2015

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John 17:14-19

[Jesus prayed, saying:]

"I gave them your word, and the world hated them, because they do not belong to the world any more than I belong to the world.

I do not ask that you take them out of the world but that you keep them from the evil one.

They do not belong to the world any more than I belong to the world.

Consecrate them in the truth.

Your word is the truth. As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world.

And I consecrate myself for them so that they also may be consecrated in truth"

## Reflection

Imagine walking through life with a giant placard around your neck that read "consecrated in truth". In fact, that is what you are and what your life is meant to proclaim to the world. Jesus prays to the Father acknowledging that the world is a very difficult place for his disciples.

Disciples of Jesus Christ live in the world and embrace it as a gift from God, but they are necessarily unsettled, looking always forward to the Kingdom that is to come. How is it that you might place too much stock in the ways of the world? What things of this world provide you the comfort that keeps you from the unsettledness of a committed disciple? Remember, you are "consecrated in truth"



### Traffic Update


Temporary Road Closure on Boundary Rd, Schofields—Schofields Rd Upgrade and Extension.
