Sunday Gospel for 28 June, 2015

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark 5:22-24. 39-42

One of the synagogue officials, named Jairus, came forward. Seeing (Jesus) he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him, saying, "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." He went off with him and a large crowd followed him.

So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep." And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Talitha kowm," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around.

Reflection

Mark is very intentional in noting whom Jesus selects to accompany him on his journey of raising the dead girl to life. Jesus takes only the girl's mother and father with him into the room. This suggests familial intimacy around the girl's bedside. Jesus succeeds in raising the girl to new life and also, undoubtedly, in establishing a new household of faith in him—a family united in thanksgiving. Do you celebrate faith as a household, as the center of family life?

Kindergarten teachers participation in the Australian Early Development Census.


