Dear Parents and Carers of St Joseph's

Here we are in Week 10 Term 4. The school year is coming to a close so quickly. This time of the year is always very busy there is so much happening.

Our school community is

- continuing to keep the focus on learning right up to the last day of school

- tidying up our classrooms in preparation for the end of year

- having maintenance being carried out at the moment as well. 
#### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CHRISTMAS HAMPER APPEAL
