## **ROADS AND TRAFFIC UPDATE**

#### Dear Parents/Carers

You are most likely aware of the new subdivision being developed adjacent to St Joseph's. Yesterday I met with representatives from Craig and Rhodes and Western Earthmoving (WEM) with Mr Mark DeSylva, CEDP Facilities officer. The outcome of the meeting was to advise you of details of the development and changes that will be happening over the coming weeks on Alex Avenue, Schofields.

I am detailing the necessary information for your reference below:-

- WEM have scheduled the road works and truck comings and goings between the hours of 9.00 am to 2.00 pm.
- There will be a Traffic Controller on duty between 9.00 am to 2.30 pm to assist pedestrians.
- Footpath access will limited between 9.00 am to 2.30 pm. The Traffic Controller will manage Pedestrian accessibility.
- Please be advised to follow the directions of the Traffic Controller for your safety.
- WEM have specific management protocols in place to ensure the site is safe by having dust control by way of water tanks and the air quality is regularly monitored.
- In approximately 2 weeks time, the footpath in front of the development site
  will be excavated to install utilities, therefore, it will not be accessible at all.
  A temporary crossing will be installed on the south side of the site and the
  traffic controller will support the crossing by directing pedestrians to use the
  crossing and walk along Alex Avenue to the official crossing in front of the
  school to access the school grounds.
- There will be 'no parking' signage in front of the development.

Western Earthmoving has provided a map illustrating the works for your reference.

I wish to express my appreciation of your support to ensure all members of our school community are safe and supported during the coming weeks with the development of the residential site.
