Afternoon Pickup Survey Results

We have had 112 replies to the survey. It was good to have the voice of so many parents!

53 use the rolling pickup

59 don't use the pickup and the majority of these parents use COSHC or Bus

Of the parents that use the rolling pickup:

Ease of Use:

80% find it very easy to use, 18% found it easy and only 1 response found it difficult to use.

Safety:

82% gave the rolling pickup the highest rating and 18% gave it the second highest rating.

Understanding of Procedures

88% gave the highest rating and 12% gave the second highest rating.

Comments from Parents Using Pickup:

There were many appreciative of the teachers. These were shared with the teachers. It was affirming for them to hear the positive comments.

Some parents expressed concerns about queueing in Flynn St and uturns in Nazarene Crescent. In last week's newsletter I spoke about staggering your arrival towards the end of the time frame for pickup as the queue is far less at that time. Also you are able to wait in Jerralong Drive and wait for the traffic to calm.

There were a couple of comments about shelter- we use the library for extreme weather.

Order with the Kindergarten and Year 1 pickup was an issue and with the help of COSHC we have been able to make some improvements.

Comments from parents walking in to pickup their children:

Most have found parking easier but not all. It could be good for these two groups to communicate so that the people finding parking difficult can find where the best spots are!

Many would like to use the rolling pickup when their children are bigger.

Some had safety concerns that are being addressed.



Mark Taylor Cricket Sheild Match Report

Round 1: St Joseph's Schofields Vs Holy Family Luddenham, 5th March 2018

On a cloud covered Autumn morning twelve Stage 3 students from St Joseph's, Schofields arrived to face the team from Holy Family, Luddenham in the first round clash of the Mark Taylor Shield for 2018. One eye was kept on the gathering clouds as the St Joseph's captains Cooper Opdam and Isaac Beacroft met the captain from Holy Family for the toss. 'Heads!' was the call from Cooper O and as Her Royal Highness gazed upward from the grass, St Joseph's elected to bowl.

Shortly after a brief warm up and team huddle St Joseph's took to the field with the Holy Family openers striding to the center. Cooper O and Charlie Liddicoat opened the bowling. Their good line and length let the Holy Family batsman know that runs were going to be hard to come by. In the fifth over of the match Cooper O crashed the ball into the stumps bringing about the first wicket of the innings. The score was 1/10. In the next over Charlie had his first wicket clean bowling the other opener. The score was now 2/11. With the boys running together to congratulate each other with high fives and hair ruffling a total of 46 was marked in the scorebook for the Holy Family innings.

The innings break was timeley as the players were forced to seek shelter when the drizzling rain increased. This gave the St Joseph's top order time to think about how they were going to face the Holy Family bowling attack once the rain cleared. Unfortunately for Alexander Whiteley this time under the marquee allowed him to think too much and he hit the very first ball of the St Joseph's innings straight to the fielder at short-cover who took the easy catch.

Charlie was then joined by Isaac B and together they built a strong partnership to get the majority of the runs required.
