FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Sunday Gospel for 23 August, 2015

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John 6:60-

Many of the disciples of Jesus who were listening said, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" Since Jesus knew that his disciples were murmuring about this, he said to them, "Does this shock you? What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? It is the Spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail. The words I have spoken to you are Spirit and life. But there are some of you who do not believe." Jesus knew from the beginning the ones who would not believe and the one who would betray him. And he said, "For this reason I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father."

As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer walked with him. Jesus then said to the Twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" Simon Peter answered him. "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God".

Reflection

It is likely that many of Jesus's followers abandoned him out of fear that they were not part of the group chosen by the lord and when he said: "no one can came to me unless it is granted him by my father." We have been chosen for a special relationship with the Father through our participation in the life of the Son. We are "Spirit and life" for the world, because the Word animates our faith.

More information will be communicated to parents after the staff have analysed the Naplan Data.





PBS4L Parent Update

Over the last Term the staff at St. Joseph's have continued working on the PBS4L Project.

On this journey, the staff has created a behaviour matrix that outlines the expected behaviour and responsibilities of each student in each area of our school. This behaviour matrix clearly outlines ways in which students can be safe, respectful and a learner in each area of our school. This behaviour matrix provides all students and staff with consistent language and expectations.

The PBS4L team will now use this behaviour matrix to create a series of short lessons that explicitly teach the skills, behaviours and expectations to create a positive school culture and learning environment. Classroom teachers will explicitly teach all children these short PBS4L lessons; this process will begin next term.

During our Mathematics Investigations, Year 2 are currently working on verbalising effective strategies in addition and subtraction.


