Dear Parents and Carers,

Canteen - Lunch Orders

Lunch Orders are to be placed via the Spriggy Schools App by 9am.

We have been advised that the only option for any orders received after 9am, will be Cheese or Vegemite sandwiches. Alternatively, you can drop lunch into the Office for your child to collect at break time – NO Uber Eats.

Please note: Orders can be placed a week in advance.

Morning Drop off and Afternoon Pick up Reminder

As we return for Term 3, just a reminder of the school's drop off and pick up methods:









Morning:

- 1. Bus Bay Drop-off:
 - a. Enter from the LEFT and there is NO RIGHT TURN in to or out of the Bus Bay;
 - b. Left turn only out of bus bay. Use the new roundabout at Beacon Drive if you need to turn right.
- 2. Nazarene Crescent Kiss & Drop:
 - a. Enter via Jerralong Drive, onto Flynn Street then onto Nazarene Crescent;
 - b. Drop off ONLY.

Afternoon:

Any changes to your child's pick up arrangements needs to be called through to the Office by 2pm.

- 1. Parent Pick up: Park in surrounding streets and walk up via the footpath to the school gate via Alex Avenue;
- 2. Rolling Pick-up: Display your number clearly. Enter via Jerralong Drive, right onto Flynn Street, right into Nazarene Cres and patiently wait for the cars to clear;
- 3. Bus: Children are supervised by the Assistant Principal to ensure they get on the right bus;
- 4. Walkers: Children are walked to the crossing where the Crossing Supervior ensures the safe crossing of Alex Avenue;
- 5. COSHC: Please notify COSHC if your child WILL NOT be attending on their scheduled day.

UNSW COMPETITIONS

We will run the UNSW competitions again this year. This is an optional assessment that you may like your child from Year 3-6 to complete. The dates for the assessment are below:

Competition Dates

English Tuesday 16th August 2022 – 3pm to 3.45pm

Mathematics Tuesday 30th August 2022 – 3pm to 3.45pm

After the test, you will be able to pick up your child from the Nazarene Gate.

The tests are done online, the students will require their iPads to complete the tests. Each test costs \$19.25. Closing date to purchase the test is **1st August**. To purchase a test, go to this link https://shop.icasassessments.com/pages/pps, and type this code JOQ747

ATTENDANCE - EVERY DAY and MOMENT OF LEARNING COUNTS

Please ensure that your child not only attends school each day but that they arrive at school on time. Arriving at school on time is just as important as being at school. *Every minute at school counts*. When your child is late to school, they miss valuable start of the day procedures and learning that sets them up for a successful day. *Remember school starts at 8.30am*. If your child arrives after 8.30am you will need to park the car and walk your child to the office as there will be no teacher to assist at the Kiss and Drop area or Nazarene Crescent gate.

If your child is away, please ensure that you write a letter to the teacher explaining why your child was absent or provide a medical certificate if appropriate. Please keep your child at home if they have any cold and flu symptoms. If they have allergies, please keep the office up to date.

ZONES OF REGULATION®


When you're entering the **YELLOW** zone, proceed with caution and slow down! The **Yellow** zone describes when you start to lose control, such as when you are frustrated, overwhelmed, silly, wiggly, excited, worried, anxious, and surprised. It is a good idea to use caution when you are in the **yellow** zone.






Within the **Yellow** zone, there are a number of tools that will assist you. Begin by talking with your child about what tool they will use for the **Yellow** Zone. Calming techniques are ideal when in the **yellow** zone. Some suggested tools are:

- counting forwards and backwards;
- using breathing techniques such as the lazy 8 breathing or shape breathing;
- rolling playdough;
- listen to music; and
- go for a walk.






